NEW UK ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR U.S. CITIZENS

Starting January 8, 2025, U.S. citizens traveling to the UK, including Northern Ireland and British Overseas Territories, must obtain an Electronic Travel Authorization (ETA) unless they have a UK visa or legal residency in the UK or Ireland. The ETA costs £10 (\$12.75), is valid for up to two years, applies to all ages, and takes up to three working days to process. Exemptions apply to British and Irish passport holders, UK visa holders, and those with an exempt vignette.
